

Outcomes and outputs:

1. National laws and regulations are more conducive for youth employment:

- The recommendations for policy change are developed and handed-over to relevant authorities;
- Advisory inputs on strategic steering, result-oriented management of the implementation of youth employment policies and programs are provided.

2. Youth Employment Support Services are integrated in the local public employment services and Youth Employment Service (YES) Desks are scaled up under the leadership of the MLSP:

- Institutional and technical capacities of GOLWS and Labour Divisions are strengthened to set-up, provide and monitor youth employment services;
- YES Desks are scaled up;
- Local cooperation and private sector partnerships to support youth employment are strengthened;
- YES Desks provide services that apply specific approaches according to the differentiated needs of women and men.

3. The national start-up support program is strengthened through capacity building and the integration of lessons learned from the project:

- Start-up support pilot approaches are disseminated at the national level jointly with GOLWS;
- Business development service providers are capacitated to implement start-up supporting activities;
- Networking to support the youth entrepreneurship is facilitated.
